



Beetroot and Black Eye Bean Salad - By Smt Rama Mahesh, NJ



Ingredients:

Nutritious and Easy to prepare salad Beetroot - 2 (medium size) Black Eyed Beans - 1/4 cup Ginger - 1/4 inch Coriander Leaves - 1 table spoon Lemon juice, salt, pepper - to taste
